Amy Bucher

Filmmaker, Senior Producer Engel Entertainment. Associate Producer, *Mr. Mummy* (1994). With almost 20 years experience (National Geographic Channel, the Discovery Channel, PBS, A&E, The History Channel, TLC, Channel 4(UK)), Amy has covered archaeology, science, wildlife, cultural and social issues. Her awards include two Cine Golden Eagles, a Chris Award, recognition by Festival du Film d'Archéologie d'Amiens, the Telluride Mountain Film Festival, the Houston International Film Festival, and nominations for two Emmy Awards.

Jeff Himpele

Cultural Anthropologist and Filmmaker, Assistant Professor NYU Dept. of Anthropology. Producer, *Taypi Kala : Six Visions of Tiwanaku* (1994). Jeff is the author of the upcoming book *Circuits of Culture : Media, Politics and Indigenous Identity in the Andes*. He has made two films on the social dynamics surrounding archaeological sites and the production of archaeological knowledge, including the award-winning *Incidents of Travel in Chichen Itza* (1997).

Peter Herdrich

AIA Trustee, Senior Producer *Inside Edition*. A NYC-based television news producer, he first became interested in archaeology during a reporting trip to Turkey, where he filed reports from Troy. For the past two years he has served on the National Governing Board of the AIA, where he heads up the Media Task Force.

Martha Goell Lubell

Filmmaker and Producer, *Queen of the Mountain* (2005). This film won both Jury and Audience awards at the Archaeology Channel Film Festival, and First Prize for People and Culture, at the Explorers' Club Film Festival. Her carefully crafted previous documentary, *Daring to Resist*, won First Prize for Holocaust Biography, International Jewish Video Competition (Berkeley CA) and the Grand Prize Documentary, Atlantic City Film Festival. Other recent credits include: *Faces of the Holocaust* and *Crosstown*.

Ronn Wade

Anatomist and Thanatologist. Consultant, *Mr. Mummy* (1994). Ronn is Director of the Maryland State Anatomy Board, and Director of the Anatomical Service Division of the University of Maryland. His cross cultural knowledge of mummies offers unique perspectives. He has published widely on the preservation of human remains, and has participated in the III World Congress on Mummy Studies.
